Kennel cough outbreaks are common in boarding situations in our local area. Similar to the human flu virus, kennel cough has different strains. Therefore, even though your pet has been vaccinated with the Bordetella vaccine, they may still contract kennel cough as a result of their stay here. Your pet could come down with kennel cough during their stay here and/or after they go home. To better care for your pet, we ask for your permission to treat your pet should they start coughing. We will notify you if this happens if you are reachable. There will be an additional cost for the medication if it is needed.

DURING MANDATORY EVACUATION, YORK VETERINARY HOSPITAL WILL NOT BE MANNED UNTIL LOCAL AUTHORITIES ALLOW RETURN TO THE PREMISES AND WILL NOT ASSUME ANY RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANIMALS ABANDONED DURING AN EVACUATION.

PETS NEEDING INTENSIVE 24-HOUR CARE CAN BE TRANSFERRED TO THE PENINSULA VETERINARY EMERGENCY CLINIC. CHARGES FOR EMERGENCY CLINIC SERVICES ARE SEPARATE AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE INCURRED BY YORK VETERINARY HOSPITAL.
